NOTICE OF EXECUTION

WHEREAS, at a Court of Common Pleas held at Philadelphia, in and for the County of Philadelphia as to information number 1207 of the August Term of the Criminal Division in the year A.D. one thousand nine hundred and ninety-eight, a certain Lance Arrington was tried upon a certain information charging him with the crime of Murder, and was on the seventeenth day of February, A.D. two thousand, found guilty of Murder in the First Degree on said information, and on the twenty-second day of February, A.D. two thousand, the jury fixed the penalty at death, and was thereupon, to wit, on the twenty-second day of February, A.D. two thousand, sentenced by the Court to suffer death; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of this Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has reviewed the matter and upheld the constitutionality of the death penalty as well as affirmed its imposition upon said Lance Arrington, and has thus transmitted to the Governor a full and complete record of the trial, sentencing hearing, imposition of sentence and review by the Supreme Court pursuant to an Act of the General Assembly of this Commonwealth entitled the "JARA Continuation Act of 1980," approved the fifth day of October, A.D. one thousand nine hundred and eighty; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to thirty-third Act of the General Assembly of the year two thousand and nine, A.D., approved on the eleventh day of August, A.D., two thousand and nine, I, as the Secretary of Corrections, am duly authorized and required by the laws of the Commonwealth to schedule and carry out the execution of said Lance Arrington;

NOW THEREFORE, this notice establishes and specifies the date of said execution in accordance with the law, specifically that the sentence of said Court of Common Pleas to be executed upon said Lance Arrington, shall be scheduled and be carried out on the seventeenth day of April, A.D. two thousand and fifteen, in the manner prescribed by the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth entitled "An Act providing for a procedure and method of execution; and making repeals," approved the eighteenth day of June, A.D. one thousand nine hundred and ninety-eight.



NOTICE OF EXECUTION

WHEREAS, at a Court of Common Pleas held at Reading, in and for the County of Berks as to information number 2456, Counts 1 and 2, of the Criminal Division in the year A.D. two thousand and eight, a certain Albert Perez was tried upon a certain information charging him with the crime of Murder, and was on the nineteenth day of May, A.D. two thousand and nine, found guilty of Murder in the First Degree on said information, and on the twenty-seventh day of May, A.D. two thousand and nine, the jury fixed the penalties at death, and was thereupon, to wit, on the twenty-seventh day of May, A.D. two thousand and nine, sentenced by the Court to suffer death; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of this Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has reviewed the matter and upheld the constitutionality of the death penalty as well as affirmed its imposition upon said Albert Perez, and has thus transmitted to the Governor a full and complete record of the trial, sentencing hearing, imposition of sentence and review by the Supreme Court pursuant to an Act of the General Assembly of this Commonwealth entitled the "JARA Continuation Act of 1980," approved the fifth day of October, A.D. one thousand nine hundred and eighty; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to thirty-third Act of the General Assembly of the year two thousand and nine, A.D., approved on the eleventh day of August, A.D., two thousand and nine, I, as the Secretary of Corrections, am duly authorized and required by the laws of the Commonwealth to schedule and carry out the execution of said Albert Perez;

NOW THEREFORE, this notice establishes and specifies the date of said execution in accordance with the law, specifically that the sentence of said Court of Common Pleas to be executed upon said Albert Perez, shall be scheduled and be carried out on the seventeenth day of April, A.D. two thousand and fifteen, in the manner prescribed by the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth entitled "An Act providing for a procedure and method of execution; and making repeals," approved the eighteenth day of June, A.D. one thousand nine hundred and ninety-eight.
