HOW TO APPLY

Civil Service Jobs: Visit the State Civil Service Commission website at www.employment.pa.gov; on the right under applicants, below the Civil Service title, click on [log in](#); on this page select the “Job Seekers” tab (above) to bring up a listing of job categories. Select a category for an alphabetical listing of job titles within that category. Select the number to the left of the job title to see a detailed test announcement that provides information concerning job requirements, pay, and job opportunities.

To complete an application on-line go to the “Job Seekers” icon, select “General Information” and select “Civil Service Application”. For most job titles you can apply online which allows you to schedule a date and time that is convenient for you. The “How to Apply” section of the test announcement will guide you. If you cannot apply online, print and complete the application and application supplement (if applicable), and mail to the SCSC address indicated on page iii of the SCSC “Instructions for the Application for Employment/Promotion”.

The SCSC publishes brochures for associates, bachelors, and master’s degree graduates. These brochures can be found under “Job Seekers”, and select “State and Local Government Career Opportunities”, and “Job Opportunities for Graduates”. Open the booklet to review job titles and minimum requirements specific to your interest and degree.

Non-Civil Service Jobs: Visit the Office of Administration, Bureau of State Employment (BSE) website at www.employment.pa.gov. Select the “Apply Now” tab and select “apply now through this web site”. You can then select the position to access a description of work, required experience, salary, benefits, etc. Select “Apply” to “create an account” or if you have an account enter your username and password to continue with the application process. **NOTE: All applications must be submitted on-line. Paper applications will no longer be accepted by BSE.**
