MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

Now, October 4, 2016, upon consideration of respondents' application to revoke petitioner's in forma pauperis status and petitioner's response thereto, the application is granted. Petitioner's in forma pauperis status is revoked, and petitioner is directed to pay the filing fee of \$65.50 within 30 days of entry of this order or this matter will be dismissed as a matter of course.

Petitioner has been granted in forma pauperis status in the present case falling within the purview of the Prison Litigation Reform Act, (PLRA) 42 Pa. C.S. §§6601-6608. He is challenging respondents' collection of costs pursuant to 42 Pa. C.S. §9728(b)(5); he does not allege that he is in imminent danger of serious bodily injury.

Petitioner has previously had at least three cases dismissed under Section 6602(e)(2) of the PLRA on the basis that they were frivolous or failed to state a claim upon which relief may be granted: *Stockton v. Chief Hearing Examiner*, No. 556 MD 2013 (dismissed for failure to state a claim); *Stockton v. Chief Hearing Examiner*, No. 90 MD 2014 (dismissed for failure to state a claim); *Stockton v. Lt. Vance*, No. 29 CD 2011 (trial court's dismissal of petition for review pursuant to Section 6602(e)(2) of the PLRA affirmed).
