MEMORANDUM ORDER

Petitioner, Jay Yunik, seeks in forma pauperis status in a case falling within the purview of the Prison Litigation Reform Act, (PLRA) 42 Pa. C.S. §§6601-6608. He alleges that he has been improperly denied a promotional transfer.

The present case essentially concerns a challenge to the level of custodial restriction applied to petitioner. Further, it involves the very type of prison management matter with which this court has previously declined to become involved. **See** *Lawson v. Department of Corrections*, 539 A.2d 69 (Pa. Cmwlth. 1988).

Accordingly, we conclude that petitioner has failed to state a cause of action and the appeal is dismissed under Section 6602(e)(2) of the PLRA, 42 Pa. C.S. §6602(e)(2). Therefore, we
