

Notice to Inmates:

As we move through this most recent process with COVID inside the facility, changes will be made to adjust to Cohort scheduling and daily functioning of the Institution.

Moving forward, you will see signs on the Units to identify the various stages of the quarantined inmates. These signs will be used mainly for Medical Staff to make for a smoother and more efficient way of handling these cases. Vulnerable inmates are going to be identified for the time being so that **ALL** staff can closely monitor for symptoms of the virus. All Housing Units will utilize this system. However, each Unit may be run differently based on the number of quarantined individuals.

Virtual Visits did begin again today and if your cohort is not on Enhanced Quarantine you will be able to receive visits. The mobile kiosks are being implemented for "long term" quarantines. As explained, you must be pulled out of the regular visit system to go onto this kiosk, so it has its drawbacks.

**There have been no changes in the instruction of wearing masks.** You **MUST** still wear your mask. We are well aware of Covid Fatigue and understand your frustrations. We feel it too!

The quarantine end date from the results of the mass testing is March 17<sup>th</sup>. We fully intend to move forward and open up the best we can after that date.

As already stated, we will adapt to the changes the best we can with your interests in mind.
