



# Top 10 Questions Asked at...

## Lackawanna County CCJ

### **1. What is my board action?**

It is a decision by the Pennsylvania Parole Board which will determine how long the program will last for you.

### **2. When will it (board action) be available?**

It is typically issued by your 45<sup>th</sup> day.

### **3. Do you have my board action?**

No. You will be notified as soon as it is forwarded to the facility.

### **4. Can you check on the status of my board action?**

Staff at the facility do not check the status of your board action. You will be notified as soon as staff at the facility receive it.

### **5. Was my home plan approved?**

It typically takes four weeks have an in-state home plan approved.

### **6. Is my old home plan still viable?**

If your parole agent informs you that your home plan is still viable, you do not have to submit a new plan.

### **7. Do I need a home plan to be released?**

No. You will be sent to a Community Corrections Center (CCC) if you do not have a home plan.

### **8. Which CCC do I need to go to?**

You will be notified of a CCC assignment when you are signed out.

### **9. What if I don't want to go to a certain CCC?**

Your placement depends on where beds are available. If there is a bed available at another location, staff can work with you so you can be placed there.

### **10. What is the process for interstate parole plan?**

It is the same as a regular home plan for Pennsylvania. However, there is a \$125 application fee for each out of state home plan that you submit. The review time usually takes between 6-8 weeks.
