



# Top 10 Questions Asked at...

## Johnstown CCC

### **1. What employment is available in the area?**

The Center Counselor may assist in directing you to numerous employers the Center has established great relationships with over the years.

### **2. How much is housing here?**

Housing varies with apartments to county assistance for housing.

### **3. What kind of routes does the bus run?**

Bus transportation varies throughout the day. The Center does have bus tokens for reentrant use.

### **4. Is treatment easily accessible after I leave here?**

Yes. There are numerous treatment centers throughout the city and they are easily accessible by walking or bus.

### **5. How much personal items can I keep at the center?**

All approved items are accessible in the handbook specifically for the Johnstown CCC.

### **6. Can I get extra time out on the weekends?**

The center counselor will review your planner (schedule) as time increases with positive adjustment at Center.

### **7. How much do they take from me?**

The Center does not take rent anymore. Work with your parole agent to discuss other possible payments for court costs, restitution, etc.

### **8. Is there lodging close for my family to visit?**

Yes. Holiday Inn is only a couple blocks away and within walking distance to Center.

### **9. How long does it take to get a home plan?**

After home plan paperwork is submitted to the Center parole agent, it takes approximately 14-28 days.

### **10. Do I have a single room to stay in?**

No. All housing rooms are dormitory style with at least two people per room.
