



A Day's Schedule at...

Luzerne County

As a parole re-entrant at the Luzerne County Work Release center, your schedule is largely dependent on your employment status.

If you are currently not employed, your schedule will be the same every day. Generally, you will leave the center at 830am and return at 830pm. You will be fed breakfast before you leave, and dinner when you return, and be provided a bag lunch to take with you. While you are out, you are expected to look for work, work toward finding a home plan address, and attend any meetings or counseling sessions as directed by your parole agent.

If you do have a job, your schedule will be based on your work schedule. If you are working a morning shift, you will leave the center early enough to include your travel time to work. You will then work your scheduled hours. After your work hours, you will be given free time to attend to your home plan issues and attend any meetings or sessions. If you work afternoon, evening, or overnight shifts, your free time will usually be before work. It should be noted, that regardless of your work schedule, you are required to spend 8-9 continuous hours at the center to ensure that you sleep.

Generally, your schedule on all of your days off will leaving the center at 8:30 am and returning at 8:30 pm.
