



A Day's Schedule at...

Johnstown CCC

Transfer to Center from the previous institution.

Complete intake with the monitors and get assigned your locker, assigned bed and a handbook. Reentrants will see their counselor and parole agent for their orientation/intake process and obtain letter from the counselor for the welfare office and if needed, clothing services.

During week one, orientation and workshops will be completed.

Week two and continuing, reentrants will sign out of the center on job searches to obtain employment, address any medical needs and attend all mandatory conditions for treatment. This will be reviewed by the reentrant's parole agent or counselor.

Bus tokens for initial travel to job interviews or specialized treatment not in close proximity to the center will be provided to the reentrant for convenience. The center has games and books available for reentrants during evening events. A resource room detailing a lot of the services in the community and other opportunities that individuals may need is located in the center. There is a kitchen area for reentrants to use as each person is responsible for all food preparation. The center does not provide meals. Family Kitchen in the local community permits reentrants to eat their for free.

The center asks all reentrants to:

- Be Responsible
- Obtain employment
- Obtain Housing
- Take care of yourself
- Transfer to Home
