1. When will my money arrive?

Generally two to three weeks after you arrive at this facility.

2. When will my property arrive?

Generally two to three weeks after you arrive at this facility.

3. When do I leave?

You need to contact your counselor to discuss your case. The counselor can provide you with that information.

4. When I finish the program, do I go home?

You need to contact your counselor to discuss your case. The counselor can provide you with that information.

5. What happens if I choose not to do the program?

The Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole will be notified. The decision as to what happens in your case is the Board's to make.

6. Can I work while doing the program?

No. You are eligible to work after you complete the required programming.

7. How do I contact the state if I have questions?

You must submit a request slip and you will be seen or receive a reply.

8. Who is my Parole Board contact person?

There are assigned individuals at the CCJ who work for the Parole Board. You will be informed who they are upon your arrival.

9. How does the phone system work?

You will receive a print-out that explains how to access the phone system.

10. How often can I see my counselor?

Every 10 days to two weeks.
