

Top 10 Questions Asked at...

York CCC

1. When will my home plan be approved?

Home plans are approved/denied approximately 14-28 days from date of submission.

2. What are my sign-outs going to be?

The STAR policy dictates sign-outs and reentrants are provided this policy upon arrival.

3. What items can I have in the center?

A property list provided upon arrival.

4. Where is the parole office and how can I get there?

The designated parole office is located at 785 Vogelsong Road in York. The phone number is 717.812.0263. The office is located along the 6N bus route.

5. How can I get my birth certificate, Social Security card and ID?

Birth certificates can be requested online. Social Security cards are available at the Social Security office. IDs can be obtained at PennDot (Pennsylvania Department of Transportation).

6. Do you feed us here?

No. There is a full kitchen in the basement with stoves, refrigerators, microwave, sinks, toaster and pots and pans.

7. Can we (family) visit him (reentrant)?

Yes. Visiting hours are Monday through Friday from 5 to 9 pm and Saturday/Sunday from 1 to 5 pm. No visitors are allowed if the reentrant is on center restriction.

8. Can we (family) deliver items, food, clothing, etc. to reentrant?

Yes. It will all be searched and must conform to the property list. Also, all food/drinks must be prepackaged and unopened.

9. Can we (reentrants) smoke?

No. Cigarettes, lighters, matches and tobacco products are all considered contraband and are not permitted within the facility.

10. Where can I get free food/clothing?

Free food is available three times a day at Lifepath, which is a two minute walk from the center. Clothing is available at Asbury Church through a referral. Contact center staff for more information.
