



Top 10 Questions Asked at...

Tomorrow's Hope

1. How much clothing is permitted in the facility?

10 shirts, 7 pairs of pants, 7 pairs of socks, 7 pairs of underwear, 3 pairs of shoes.

2. Who will be my parole agent?

You will be assigned an agent from the Altoona District parole office and he/she is on site.

3. Do we have to bring our own food?

No. We provide three home-style cooked meals a day. Coffee, juice and tea is provided throughout the day at no cost to the reentrant.

4. Are we permitted to smoke in facility?

Yes. You may smoke in designated areas. However, no loose leaf tobacco is permitted.

5. Do you supply transportation?

Yes. We have a shuttle system that transports to the Altoona area throughout the day.

6. Are we permitted a vehicle?

Yes. However, a current driver's license, insurance and registration cards must be provided prior to bringing vehicle onto Tomorrow's Hope property. Your parole agent will also need to approve.

7. How do I submit a home plan?

You need to get a form from your case worker and turn it in to the facility parole agent.

8. How long will it take to get a home plan approved after submitting?

It will usually take between 14-28 days for an approval.

9. How long will I be on a "black out" period?

It will last seven days. If you already have a job, you may get approval from your parole agent to start without serving your seven day black out period.

10. Does Tomorrow's Hope do furloughs?

Yes. After you have been here 30 days, you can request a furlough.
