GEO Luzerne

The primary purpose of GEO Walker Hall/Luzerne Treatment Center is to provide the reentrants with the necessary tools to successfully reenter the community. The intent is to prepare each reentrant with the ability to make choices that give them the best opportunity to:

- Maintain a crime free lifestyle
- Remain clean and sober

- Be productive members of society
- Rejoin their families and social structures in a healthy manner

GEO Walker Hall/Luzerne Treatment Center offers both individual therapy and group sessions. Programming is structured to address the individualized treatment needs of reentrants who are addressing chemical dependence recovery needs, anti-social and criminal behaviors/thinking errors, and developing healthy/supportive relationships in the community.

A typical day at GEO Walker Hall/Luzerne Treatment Center:

Breakfast
Morning Medications
Morning Meeting
Core Lecture/Job Readiness/Guest Speakers
Lunch
Static Group/Core Lecture
Individual Sessions
Dinner

If eligible, reentrants are permitted family visits on Wednesday evenings and Saturday mornings for one hour. Reentrants are able to purchase a phone card every week from the facility in order to stay in contact with loved one. Reentrants are permitted to have \$40 cash on them during the week to use for personal use and vending machines. This must be dropped off via postal money order and will be given to the reentrants on Thursdays. Ordering out from select pizzerias on the weekend is another privilege that reentrants must earn. This will be determined by the clinical staff.

Upon successful completion of the program, reentrants will receive a discharge summary, an aftercare plan, and a certificate of completion from the counselor.
